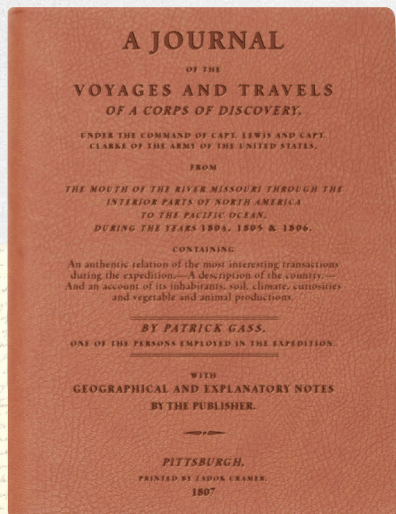

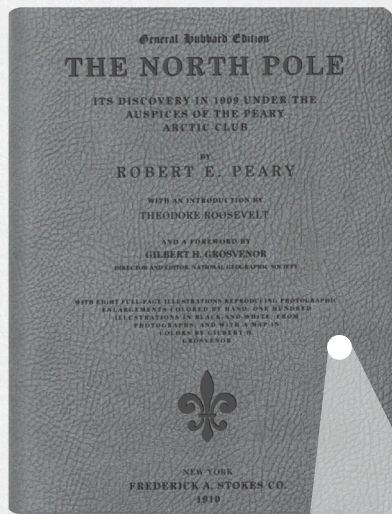

The title page from Robert E. Peary's account of his expedition to the North Pole, first published in 1910. Work included illustrations and maps of the trechorous journey.



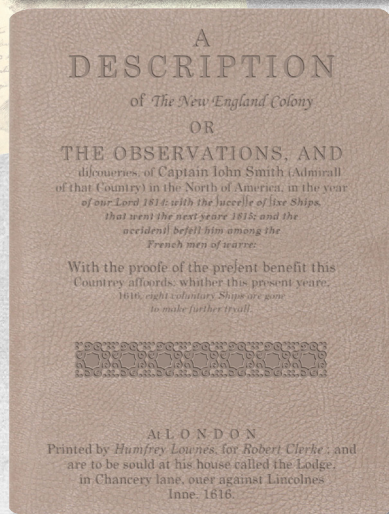

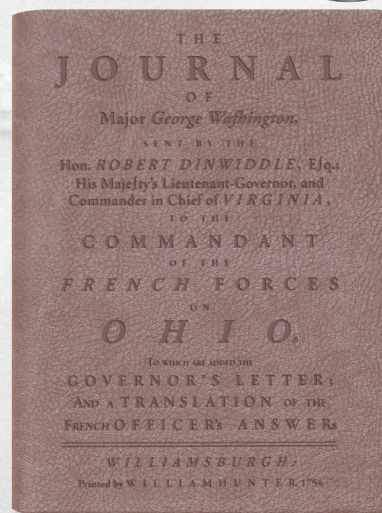
Based on the title page from John Smith's account of the first permanent colony in America in the year 1614, including their significant trials and tribulations.

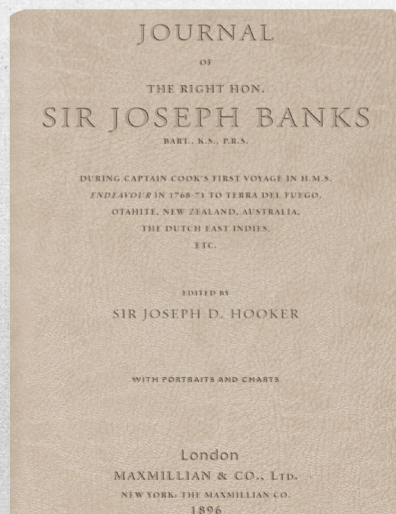

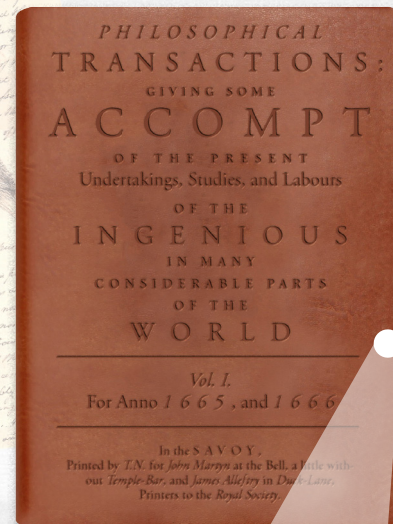

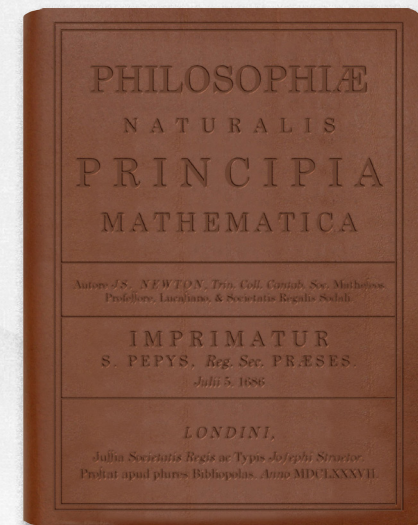

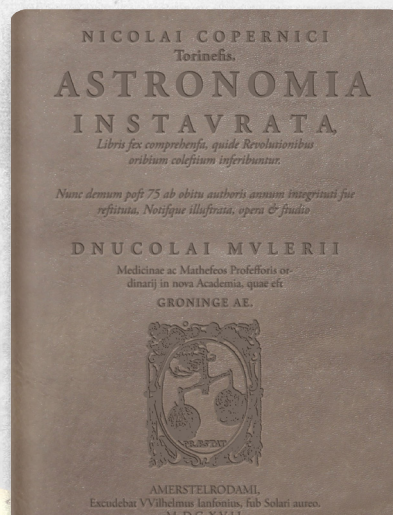
Known throughout the world as simply Principia, Sir Isaac Newton's classic work printed in London in the year 1687

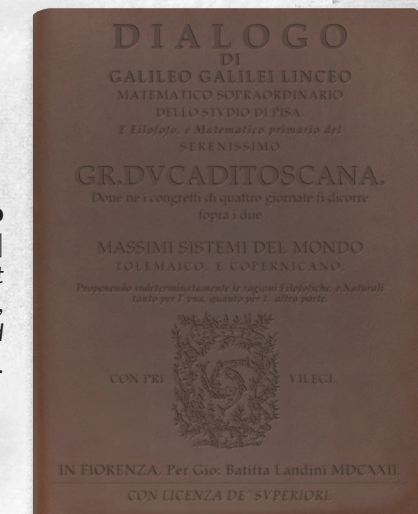
Nicolai Copernicus' classical work first published after his death because of the heretical nature of his astronomical observations, here from the 1618 printing in Amsterdam.
