

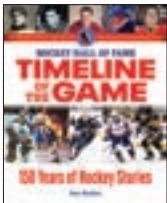

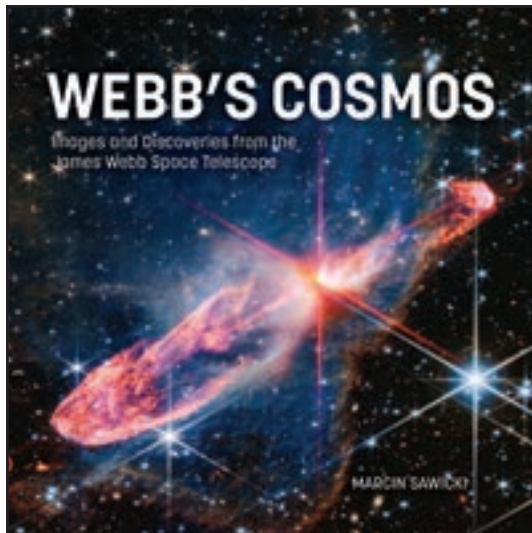

WEBB'S COSMOS

Images and Discoveries from the James Webb Space Telescope

Marcin Sawicki

The James Webb Space Telescope took three decades from conception to launch but the wait has been worth it. The results of the most anticipated telescope of the 21st century have been nothing short of spectacular.

The idea for the James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) was first raised in 1989, well before the enormously successful Hubble Space Telescope was launched. The infrared telescope with a mirror larger than four meters was launched on Christmas Day 2021.

In the summer of 2022, NASA released the first scientific images from Webb to the amazement of more than 300,000 viewers who watched the event live, and hundreds of millions around the world who have viewed Webb's images since then.

Webb's Cosmos is written in the spirit of Terry Dickinson's enormously popular book *Hubble's Universe*, which has sold over 100,000 copies. This book contains both the classic Webb images that have already become famous and the latest images from the frontiers of science taken by Webb, some of which appear here for the first time.

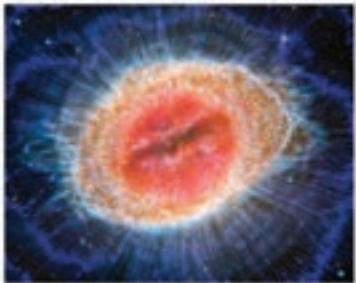
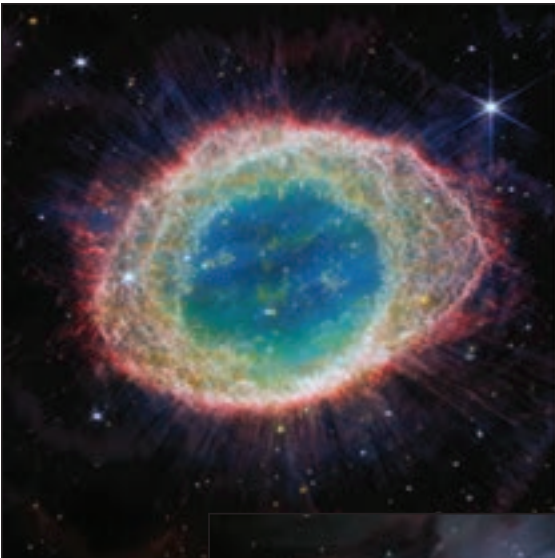
Author Marcin Sawicki is a professional astronomer who is an active user of Webb's images and data. He brings a wealth of knowledge and personal experience to the book and explains the science behind the images in accurate but accessible and engaging language.

Webb's Cosmos first provides the needed historical and scientific background to understand how the telescope works and what it can do. The book then presents a curated selection of some 200 photographs with descriptive captions that narrate these images of the distant universe. Chapters include:

- Stars and gas clouds
- Galaxies both near and far
- Planets and our solar system
- Exoplanets.

Marcin Sawicki is a professional research astronomer who has been involved with the James Webb Space Telescope Project for more than two decades and is now extensively using Webb for research. He is the co-author of 20 research papers based on data taken with Webb. A professional educator and experienced science communicator, Sawicki is Professor of Astronomy and Physics at Saint Mary's University and has held prestigious appointments: Canada Research Chair, Canadian Space Agency Science Fellow and Plaskett Fellow.





Look at the inner nebula
These often take comparatively close-up views of the Ring Nebula. This is a smaller section of what was once a planetary nebula, a cloud of gas and dust that has been ejected from a star. The inner nebula is the core of the nebula, where the gas and dust are most concentrated. The outer nebula is the shell of the nebula, where the gas and dust are more spread out. HOLOCAUST HERO

The Life and Times of Rudolf Vrba

Holocaust scholar Raul Hilberg declared there were only two great Holocaust heroes — the leader of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising (Mordechai Anielewicz) and Rudolf Vrba. After he escaped from Auschwitz-Birkenau in April of 1944, Vrba and his co-escapee Alfréd Wetzler co-authored the Vrba-Wetzler Report, credited with saving 200,000 Hungarian Jews. "No other single act in the Second World War," according to World War II historian Sir Martin Gilbert, "saved so many Jews from the fate that Hitler and the SS had determined for them."

As one of the 20th century's most important whistleblowers, Vrba also stands out in Claude Lanzmann's *Shoah* as a handsome, charismatic and cheerful iconoclast. But the Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum in Israel has limited public awareness of Vrba because he consistently criticized Jewish leaders for failing to adequately forewarn Jews of their fate.

Holocaust Hero: The Life & Times of Rudolf Vrba is the introductory volume for a biography project to examine the remarkable life of Rudolf Vrba; including his decorated service with the partisans, his love affairs, his two marriages, his accomplishments as a Nazi hunter and his iconoclastic stamina to always speak the truth about the Holocaust.

Compiled over a five-year period by a journalist who knew Vrba, ***Holocaust Hero*** provides previously unrevealed information about Vrba based on research at the FDR Presidential Library in New York and interviews with those who knew him, including Robin Vrba, his wife of 31 years, who speaks candidly about her husband for the first time.

Alan Twigg is a veteran journalist and author of 20 previous books. He also has his country's highest civilian honor, the Order of Canada, and recently received an honorary doctorate from Simon Fraser University. He became the first writer to gain the trust of Robin Vrba (Vrba's wife) after building a website about Rudolf Vrba (rudolfvrba.com). A previous biography he wrote, *Moon Madness*, profiles a courageous Norwegian-born physician, Louise Jilek-Aall, an epilepsy researcher who was the last living doctor to have worked alongside Albert Schweitzer.

"Rudi was gorgeous and totally charismatic. And he was funny. I remember we were in Auschwitz for a documentary. We were doing the film inside the camp. Then it was about 5:30 and it was time to leave. We were trying to get out. The gate had been locked. It was really muddy. Everybody started to really fret. How are we going to get out? And Rudi said, loudly, so everyone could hear, 'Never mind. I know another way out!'"

THE LIFE OF ANNE FRANK

In August 1944, Anne Frank and her family were arrested. Anne was taken to Bergen-Belsen concentration camp where she died of typhus in early 1945, about six months after her arrest and just weeks before the British liberated the camp in April 1945. Anne's father fulfilled his promise and published 1,500 copies of *Achterhuis*, or *The Secret Annex*, in German. Since then the newly named *Anne Frank: The Diary of a Young Girl* has sold over 30 million copies in 70 languages.

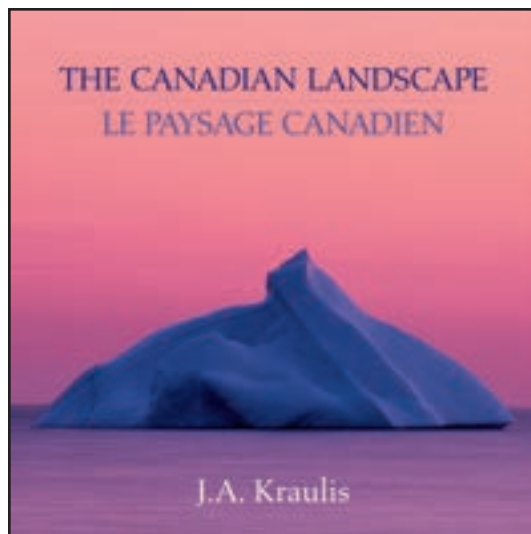
Anne wrote the diary during the 25 months that her family of four and four others were hiding in the top floor of an Amsterdam office building, now the Anne Frank Museum, which welcomes one and a half million visitors each year.

The Life of Anne Frank is a compelling factual account and timeline of those two years. Fascinating photographs show the still unchanged Annex, including the hidden entrance, and text takes readers directly inside to reveal the surroundings and Anne's story.

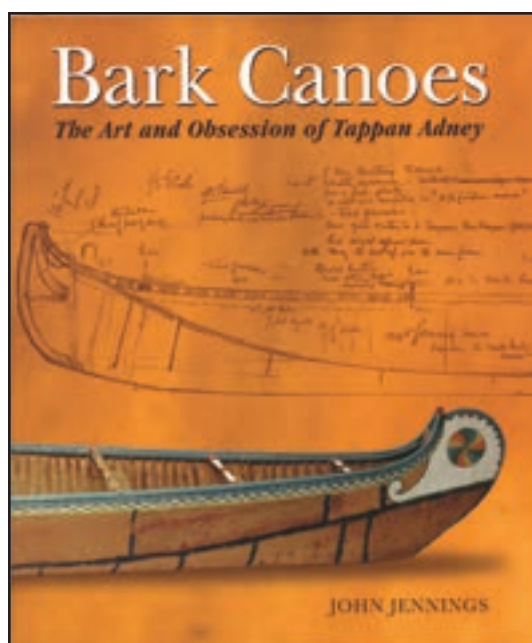

The bark canoe was the method of water travel for centuries, by native people in North America. The canoe made possible hunting, trade, and communication between native groups.

Edwin Tappan Adney singlehandedly preserved the fading history of Indigenous bark canoe construction in North America.

He built 110 historically accurate canoe models, many based on canoes that were the last remaining example of their type. Adney calculated that his canoe models consumed over 20,000 hours of detailed drawing, research and building.

Bark Canoes profiles Adney's life and life's work. Born in the United States in 1868, he lived much of his adult life in Canada. His last years were spent almost penniless in a small bungalow in New Brunswick.

Canoe research and model building were only one of the passions that drove this extraordinary man. Respected by scholars for his work with canoes, ethnography and Native languages, he struggled against enormous odds to create and preserve his models and papers.

Now owned by the Mariners' Museum in Newport News, Virginia, 110 of his beloved canoe models have been photographed and are presented here in splendid color. This book is a great resource for anyone interested in the history of Indigenous people — and how they lived — in North America.

Author **John Jennings** compiled the critically-acclaimed *The Canoe: A Living Tradition* republished by Firefly Books in 2025. Professor Jennings specializes in the frontier history of the Canadian and American West.

Teaching himself about Ontario and Quebec furniture from past centuries, he bought sturdy pioneer furniture that was still widely available then, and built a pond and stone-and-log house that was his home for many years.

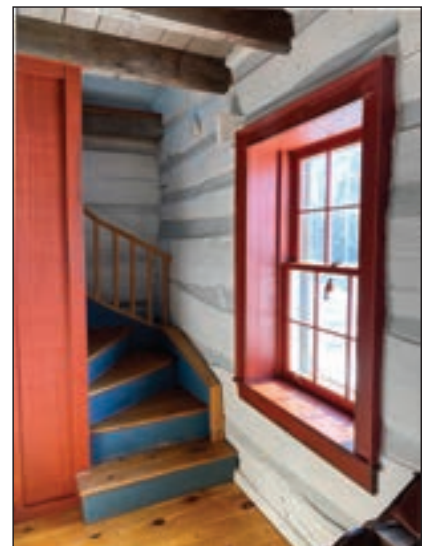
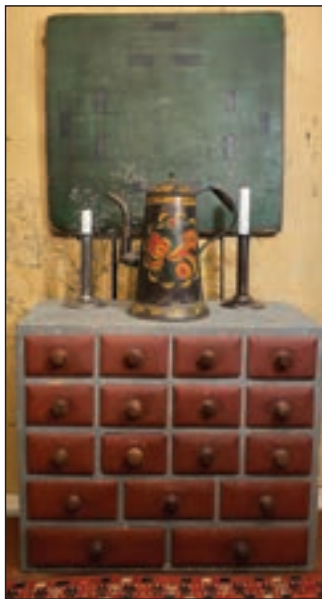
But learning how to restore his own home gave him a new business: scouring upstate New York and New England and eastern Canada for finely created old houses to be moved and restored, and barn foundations from the 19th century that could be used for the beautifully cut and split granite that would be re-used for restored stone foundations and chimneys.

A Dedication to Beauty relates the stories of 26 beautiful reconstructions and restorations, from the first square-timber house to reconstructions of log, post-and-beam, and stone houses that were first built as far east as Nova Scotia, and from the gigantic pines of northern Ontario. Each provided challenges, from discovery to carefully bringing logs out of the regrown bush — sometimes over frozen lakes in winter.

Numbering logs and stones for re-assembly, and finding craftsmen adept at the old arts was a part of the process. Next was finding the right authentic furniture and finishes to bring the houses to their maximum beauty.

All 26 are described and shown here (along with the people who owned them) with more than 320 full color pictures of 18th and 19th century antiques, the elements of the structures as they were being rebuilt, and the final results. And it was more than a business for Mel Shakespeare — the relationships with the people, the structures and the antiques resonate throughout the thoughtful and often humorous text.

This is a book for everyone interested in the old structures and furniture of Eastern North America. Previously published in an edition limited to 350 copies, it is now available at a popular price.

Preparation for War

As Europe prepared for war, military aircraft production in the United States increased rapidly. Apart from an increase in foreign orders from the British, French, Chinese, Dutch, Polish, and Soviet, the Americans actually sold more, which required WWII production, different from the aircraft in the USAAF, and US Navy in 1939. In those days an order for Mustang was considered enormous.

The aircraft industry wanted to develop a new design pitched up significantly in 1970. Defense was still rising, however, ineffective with foreign orders such as L-1011 jets, aircraft were produced in the United States in 1970. The French was following the L-1011. President Kennedy called for the United States to continue to expand production of aircraft in 1970 and the aircraft industry was able to do the same number of aircraft with the L-1011, doubling 30,000 aircraft and the L-1011 was 11,000.

Although production starts very slow, biomass was producing quickly, highest and fastest. The Goodland P in Lightening Yellow P 16 and F40 lighters were in production along with heavy fuel oils like the Marine B17 and Goodland B16. The US Navy had the Chemical F40 White Light along with the Chrysler 1000 description and the first production of the Chrysler 1000 (1964) lighters then made in New York in May 1964.

The reader can add perspective to go from two- to three-dimensions: create volume turning a square into a box, add depth turning a circle into a cylinder, create distance making railway tracks disappear. A one-quarter view of a box is different than from the front, and an open box even more different.

Nature Note
The Baltimore Oriole is very similar to its two closest relatives: the Bullock's Oriole of western North America (left) and the Wood Nuthatch Oriole of central Mexico (right).

The Baltimore Oriole is an extremely song-loving bird. Its large and black feathers make it a favorite backyard bird. Feeding its young associated with a higher lifespan. Researcher teams predicted that the Baltimore Oriole was not actually a full species, but a subspecies. In general, a species is an organism that only mates with others of its own kind. In some areas of North America, the western Baltimore Oriole often interbreeds with the more eastern Baltimore Oriole. The two birds look different, but scientists determined they were not different enough to be considered separate species. They were merged together into a single species called the Baltimore Oriole, and the different-looking populations were considered subspecies. Then in 1993, new scientists found more information about the relationships between the two Baltimore Oriole populations, and it was decided that they were distinct enough to be considered separate species after all. To recognize the Baltimore Oriole back as its own species, the lumping (combining) was an ironic species together.

Nature Note
The red in the above Northern Cardinal's feathers is from pigments. Pigments are used to color paint. For example, the blue in this Blue Jay feather (below) is caused by how light hits the structure of the feather. Many other blue things in nature are similar. For example, the blue on the surface of a blueberry is also caused by how light hits the structure of the berry's surface.

Nature Note
You may be surprised to learn that one of the Wood Duck's favorite foods is acorns! These ducks can sometimes be seen walking along a forest floor looking under oak trees for a snack.

In this Wood Duck nest, two Wood Duck eggs and one Hooded Merganser egg have hatched. This shows that a female Hooded Merganser laid at least one egg in this nest and the female Wood Duck incubated it along with her own eggs.

The male Wood Duck is one of the most colorful ducks in the world. This colorful species is also one of the planet's smallest ducks, weighing just over a pound (953 g). Female Wood Ducks are small enough to fit into small tree cavities and old woodpecker holes such as those made by the Pileated Woodpecker (see page 70). She uses these types of cavities as a nesting site, lining it with her own down feathers to help keep her eggs warm. But not all the eggs in her nest are necessarily her own. Wood Ducks and a few other duck species are known as "egg dumpers." This means that some female ducks will lay their eggs in the nests of other females, sometimes even laying them in the nest of another duck species. They then leave those eggs to be raised by the female who incubates them. This egg dumping breeding strategy is comparable to the old saying, "Don't put all your eggs in one basket." If, for example, all your eggs are in one nest and a raccoon finds it, none of your eggs will survive. But if you spread your eggs out, at least some might escape predation and hatch. Birds have evolved many different strategies to make sure that at least some of their young have a chance to become adults and have young of their own.

Once they hatch, Wood Duck ducklings may have to jump from a height of over 50 feet (15.2 m) to join their mother on the ground before they waddle off to the closest pond. That's more than a four-story drop!

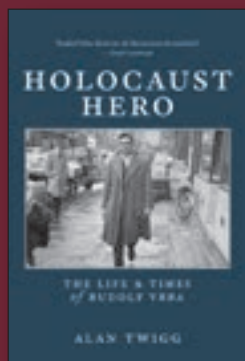
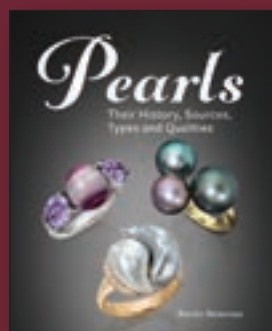
