Wishing you a spring filled with books, baseball, and all the people and things you love most.



GERELCHIMEG BLACKCRANE is a Mongolian writer of natural literature and a researcher of native Chinese mastiffs. He has published many novels, including *Black Flame*, *The Wolverine River*, *Smoke from Wolf Valley*, and *Six Seasons of Reindeer*. He has collaborated with Jiu'er on picture books, including *The Moose of Ewenki*, also published by Aldana Libros. Many of his works have been translated into more than ten languages and exported abroad, with a wide readership of children and adults. He currently lives in the Hulunbuir Grassland.

JIU'ER is a sculptor and picture book writer. She has won many awards, including the Wenjin Book Award, the Feng Zikai Children's Picture Book Award, the Chen Bochui International Children's Literature Award for Book of the Year (Picture Book), the Aesop Accolades, and the Freeman Book Award for Children's Literature (Honorable Mention).
