This is our not-so-secret invitation to you: Come celebrate with us by exploring our fun, instructive, and beautiful fall titles!

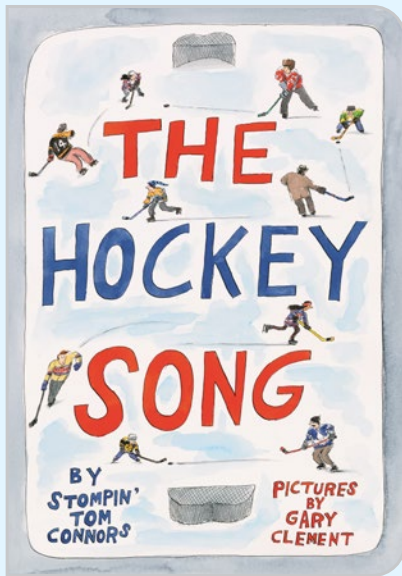

"And fish that sing, and adaptations!" Nakina says.

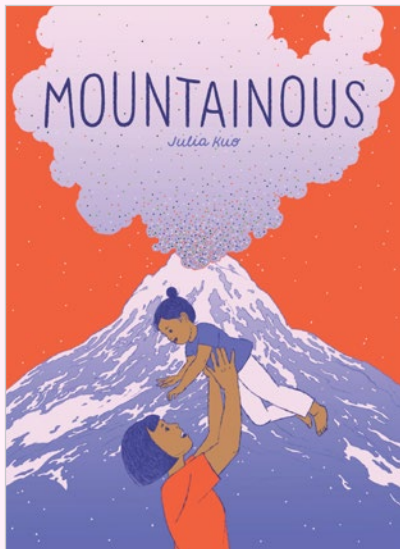
Bompa nods. "You could learn more ways to protect the plants and animals that live here."
